## SHOP TILL YOU DROP: The Great Girlfriend Getaway 2 Days/1 Nights Tour

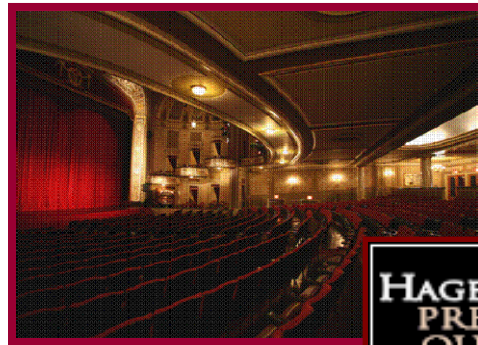
### Tour Highlights:

### Day 1:

Arrive at **Hagerstown Premium Outlets** (100+ brand name stores!) for shopping. Discount coupons provided. Take a quick break for Lunch in the **Food Court** at Premium Outlets.

Depart for antique shopping at **Beaver Creek Antique Mall**. Continue on to Boonsboro, MD for a stop at **Turn The Page Bookstore**, owned by **New York Times Bestselling author Nora Roberts**. Also visit lots of shops and boutiques while there – Nora even has a gift shop, **Gifts Inn Boonsborough!**



### Evening Options:

-Dinner and a Show at the **Washington County Playhouse**. Audiences enjoy classic Broadway, comedies, dramas, revues, and other theatrical works. Serving up professional quality productions, extraordinary customer service, and good food & drink served buffet style.

-Dinner and a Show in our **Arts & Entertainment District** at the **Academy Theatre, Banquet & Conference Center** – home of the **Potomac Playmakers**. They are proudly one of the nation's oldest community theater groups, organized in 1926.

-Dinner and a Show in our **Arts & Entertainment District** at the **Schmankerl Stube** Bavarian Restaurant or at any of the many restaurants in the A&E District. Afterwards, walk across the street to the Maryland Theatre, our "Grand Lady of the Performing Arts." Take in a play or a ballet, a performance by the **Maryland Symphony Orchestra**.

-Enjoy a night of great food and entertainment at the **Luhr's Center for the Performing Arts**.

### Day 2:

Depart for historic downtown **Hagerstown** and arrive first at the **Washington County Arts Council**, and stroll the streets and shop in of the several boutiques within a short stroll of **Public Square**. Wend your way to the **Miller House & Gardens**, an early 19th century brick townhouse with period furnishings. In addition to C&O Canal and Civil War memorabilia, their collections include local pottery, dolls & toys, quilts and country store items. Depart for the **Washington County Museum of Fine Arts**. Their collection of over 6,000 objects ranges from the Old Masters to 20th century paintings, sculpture and decorative arts.
